## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION - TOOTH DECAY

I write in response to your request for information in relation to tooth decay admissions within NHS Lothian.

## Question:

- 1. How many people in your heath boards jurisdiction have been diagnosed with tooth decay issues in each year since 2018?
- 2. How many people in your heath boards jurisdiction (aged 18 and under) have been diagnosed with tooth decay issues in each year since 2018?

## Answer:

We can only provide the numbers of patients with tooth decay for inpatients, and the numbers for each year and age group are contained below.

| Year | All Ages | Under 18s |

| 2018 | 1,448    | 1,123     |
| 2019 | 1,458    | 1,070     |
| 2020 | 647      | 477       |
| 2021 | 740      | 602       |
| 2022 | 1,054    | 856       |
| 2023 | 1,016    | 763       |
