I write in response to your request for information in relation to respiratory triage in NHS Lothian.

Question:

I would be grateful if NHS Lothian could provide relevant information for NHS Lothian or, more specifically, the Western General Hospital as to:

1. In July 2019, whether Lothian/WGH had a protocol for the Emergency Department's triage of respiratory/lung presentations?

Answer:

There is no Emergency Department at the Western General Hospital. The Emergency Departments at the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh and St John's Hospital had a triage protocol which included respiratory presentations on this date.

2. In July 2019, whether Lothian/WGH had a protocol for the Acute Receiving Department's triage of respiratory/lung presentations?

Answer:

Yes, a triage protocol was in place on this date which included respiratory presentations.

Question:

3. In July 2019, whether Lothian/WGH had a protocol for the administration of troponin tests, in terms of timings and repeat testing?

Answer:

Yes, a protocol was in place.
