Include Inpatients with local procedures of Cataract Treatment and 2nd Eye Cataract Treatment and a True waiting list type

Include a count of unique waiting list entry identifier as number of waits Include 90th percentile instead of longest wait

Current waits are those still on the waiting list at time of extraction

To protect the identity of the individuals involved we have used the 98^{th} percentile in the table above. Since we do not have their consent to release this data from their records, the information is exempt under section 38(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act i.e. to provide it would breach the Data Protection Act (2018).
