FREEDOM OF INFORMATION - ONLYFANS

I write in response to your request for information in relation to the website OnlyFans.

Question:

In the past 3 years, have any visits to the website 'OnlyFans.com' been recorded on NHS systems or devices (including mobile devices) used by NHS staff and what proportion of these staff were in management positions? I am defining management positions to include operational managers, facilities and estates managers, IT managers, chief executives and directors on the health board and workforce managers (manages staff and other employees).

If 3 years is too long, then can I ask for this information for the last calendar year (2024 - 2025) and the first six months of 2025 as of 30 May 2025.

If such visits to this site were recorded, please provide:

- The number of unique instances where the site was accessed.
- The dates and times (if available) when these accesses occurred.
- Whether the accesses were made during working hours.
- Whether these visits were flagged or investigated by IT or security teams.

Answer:

I am advised that this website falls into a category that we block, so there has been no access from NHS Lothian devices to this web site.

I hope the information provided helps with your request.

If you are unhappy with our response to your request, you do have the right to request us to review it. Your request should be made within 40 working days of receipt of this letter, and we will reply within 20 working days of receipt. If our decision is unchanged following a review and you remain dissatisfied with this, you then have the right to make a formal complaint to the Scottish Information Commissioner within 6 months of receipt of our review response. You can do this by using the











Scottish Information Commissioner's Office online appeals service at www.itspublicknowledge.info/Appeal. If you remain dissatisfied with the Commissioner's response you then have the option to appeal to the Court of Session on a point of law.

If you require a review of our decision to be carried out, please write to the FOI Reviewer at the email address at the head of this letter. The review will be undertaken by a Reviewer who was not involved in the original decision-making process.
