FREEDOM OF INFORMATION – COVID-19 VACCINE

I write in response to your request for information in relation to COVID-19 vaccine.

Question:

- I am requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine batch FN1664. I have been advised by Public Services Delivery Scotland that if any incidents occurred during storage or transportation of this batch, relevant records may be held by the UK Health Security Agency. Please provide any information held relating to batch FN1664 concerning:
 - temperature excursions;
 - cold-chain breaches;
 - storage deviations;
 - transportation incidents;
 - thawing, handling or expiry management issues;
 - safety assessments, incident summaries, investigation findings or corrective actions relating to the above.

Answer:

We have reviewed the information available to us regarding Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine batch FN1664 and can confirm that according to our records we did not encounter any issues detailed above.

I hope the information provided helps with your request.

If you are unhappy with our response to your request, you do have the right to request us to review it. Your request should be made within 40 working days of receipt of this letter, and we will reply within 20 working days of receipt. If our decision is unchanged following a review and you remain dissatisfied with this, you then have the right to make a formal complaint to the Scottish Information Commissioner within 6 months of receipt of our review response.
